

## Perris North Groundwater Program: Perris North Pipeline Project


In the summer of 2021, Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) began work on an important pipeline project as part of the Perris North Groundwater Program in the City of Moreno Valley.

The Perris North Pipeline Project will allow us to move water from the new groundwater wells in the Moreno Valley area to a planned groundwater treatment facility at Perris Boulevard, between Cottonwood Avenue and Bay Avenue.

The new pipelines will be constructed in three phases. The first phase was completed in August 2021. The second phase will begin construction in Spring/Summer 2023, primarily along Kitching Street. The third phase will be constructed in late 2023; primarily along Perris Boulevard.

Construction on these pipelines will be done during daytime hours; with the exception of the third phase, which may require some night work along Perris Boulevard. Work in front or in close proximity of school sites, will be done either during summer break or with reduced working hours to accommodate school schedules. Final paving will occur after project completion in coordination with the City of Moreno Valley.

The Perris North Groundwater Program is an important part of EMWD's Groundwater Reliability Plus initiative, which will increase our reliance on local groundwater and help our region become more sustainable, especially during periods of statewide water shortages.





## **Quick Facts: Perris North Groundwater Program**

- EMWD received an agency-record grant from the State Water Resources Control Board to fund approximately half of the estimated project cost for the Perris North Groundwater Program. The grant is funded through the voter-approved Proposition 1 Water Bond of 2014.
- The Program will include seven groundwater wells, approximately 16 groundwater monitoring well locations, a centralized treatment facility, and conveyance pipelines.
- Work on this Program began in late 2020 and consists of multiple phases. The total project completion date is still to be determined.
- The Program will improve groundwater quality in the North Perris Groundwater Basin, located in the Moreno Valley area, and also increase local water supply in the region.
