

# MEAD VALLEY CAJALCO CORRIDOR WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT PHASE I - ROBINSON ST

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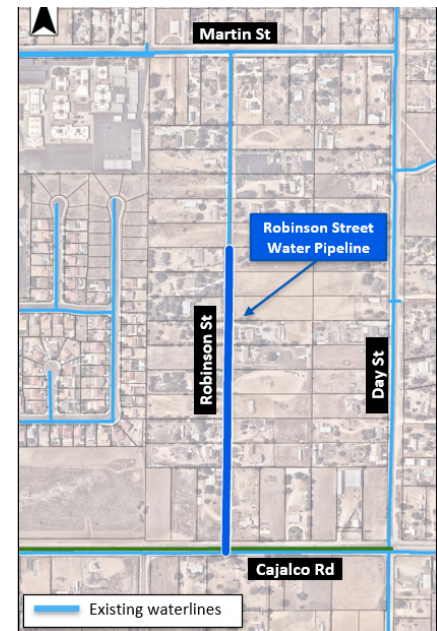
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## PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

In the summer of 2024, Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) will begin work on the Mead Valley Cajalco Corridor Water System Improvements Project Phase I- Robinson Street Pipeline Project. The project will install over 1,700 feet of eight-inch diameter pipeline that will help improve water pressure for the homes down a portion of Robinson Street. The project will see remote water meters relocated to the front of properties, and the new pipeline will connect to the existing waterlines located on Cajalco Road and Robinson Street. The project will improve water delivery and pressure for the community.



## PROJECT IMPACTS/WHAT TO EXPECT:

Work on the pipeline will take place on Robinson Street between Cajalco Road and Martin Street. During construction residents can expect:

- Temporary noise, dust, and vibrations from construction work
- Temporary water service interruptions with advance notice
- New installation and replacement of water meters, back flow devices, and pressure regulator valves (PRV)
- Potential lane closures during daytime work, but access to residents will be maintained

## PROJECT TIMELINE:

Construction of the pipeline is anticipated to begin in the summer of 2024 and be completed by the late winter of 2025
