

Wells 201, 202, 203 and 205 Equipping

In the Summer of 2021, Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) will begin work on important infrastructure projects that will help us continue to provide a safe and reliable water supply for our customers.

In 2019, EMWD completed the drilling of four new groundwater wells in San Jacinto. EMWD is now advancing the construction of the mechanical and electrical components that will help us pump the groundwater from the well and send it to a planned groundwater treatment facility in San Jacinto.

Equipping of these wells will also include the construction of a small building surrounding the well equipment, new fencing around EMWD's facilities, and communications equipment. A similar well building is shown on the back of this page.

This work will take place during daytime hours and is expected to be complete in the winter of 2023-24. Work at the four well sites will be staggered, and EMWD will communicate planned work schedules with residents throughout the project.

These new wells are an important part of EMWD's [Groundwater Reliability Plus initiative](#), which will increase our reliance on local groundwater and help our region become more sustainable, especially during periods of statewide water shortages.
